Counterterrorism Awareness for Law Enforcement and Understanding Islam and Arab Culture

Course Description:

Counterterrorism Awareness for Law Enforcement was created in response to the New Jersey Attorney General's Law Enforcement Directive 2004-3 that mandates counterterrorism awareness training for all law enforcement officers in the state of New Jersey. The topics covered include International Terrorism, Domestic Terrorism, Officer Safety, New Jersey Suspicious Activity Reporting System, and the Terrorist Screening Center. Understanding Islam and Arab Culture was created in response to the growing and diverse populations in the State of New Jersey. The topics covered include Islamic history, geographic understanding of the Middle East, comparative religion, Islamic sects including Shia, articles of belief, Islamic Law, role of women, Pillars of Islam, Arab culture, Arab politics, and interviewing techniques.

The P.A.T.R.I.O.T System™ interactive two-day workshop and field exercise is designed to provide sworn law enforcement officers who routinely and regularly patrol and monitor activities at mass transit terminals, airports, sporting events, shopping malls, theme parks, school complexes, and other high-volume pedestrian and traffic venues with training on using the P.A.T.R.I.O.T. System™ in order to detect, deter, or minimize terrorist attacks. This workshop focuses on suspicious behaviors and provides proactive threat mitigation training using an additional effective layer of security within existing budget and resource constraints. This workshop will explain the methodology used by law enforcement and security personnel to detect suspicious behaviors related to terrorist and/or criminal activity.

Patriot System Training

Course Description:

Protecting the Homeland Innovations, LLC, provides training on using the ProActive Terrorist Recognition and Interdiction Operations and Tactics™ formally known as Behavior Assessment Screening System© to detect, deter, or minimize terrorist attacks. It is our intention to provide proactive threat mitigation training using an additional effective layer of security within existing budget and resource constraints for the elevated terrorism threat level. The goals of training are to identify persons who may be high security risks in high security public places based on behavior and appearance; conduct a brief non-custodial interview and determine if a person is high risk or low risk; take appropriate risk mitigating action; and identify proactive areas of acceptable resolution. Each agency needs to sign and return a License Agreement given by the vendor. Students must have completed a Methods of Instruction course. Each student must also sign and return an Instructor License Agreement (provided by vendor) along with a registration form.

Course Name

Security Awareness and Vigilance for Everyone (SAVE)

Course Description:

Security Awareness and Vigilance for Everyone (SAVE) is a training program that fills the gap in the patron screening process at “soft targets” such as mass transit, non-secure public areas of airports, hotels, sporting events, shopping malls, theme parks, and many government facilities. The combination of high-patron volume in confined areas with no screening makes such places ideal targets for a terrorist attack. The one-day S.A.V.E. training program provides security personnel with a behavior assessment technique to counter these threats and enhance security measures in the layered defense concept. This training program will enhance the capabilities of security personnel responsible for protecting specific areas of infrastructure by providing behavior assessment screening training. After attending this training, participants will have a better understanding of the threat to their sector and their role in identifying and reporting suspicious behavior.

State and Local Anti-Terrorism Training (SLATT) Sovereign Citizen Workshop

Course Description:

State, local, and tribal patrol and street-level law enforcement officers as well as court officials/officers and analytical personnel assigned to a unit with responsibilities in the area of information gathering and/or investigation of terrorism and criminal extremism will benefit from this training. Course topics address the basic beliefs of sovereign citizens and the threats that the criminal extremist element of sovereign citizens present to law enforcement officers. Extensive coverage will be afforded to indicators that law enforcement officers can observe and hear to better enable them to recognize sovereign citizens and determine the level of threat. Emphasis will be given to the problems that sovereign citizens present in court and other legal situations. The various financial frauds employed by sovereign citizens will also be discussed.

NJLEARN COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

NJOHSP Course Catalog Descriptions

The following requirements must be met in order for users to access the NJLearn Online course:

Access to NJLearn is primarily granted to New Jersey First Responders responsible for “managing” critical incidents, rather than those “supporting” critical incidents. This is a charter decision, based on licenses, the grant funding, and current practice. Federal employees and U.S. Military employees are not granted access. Primarily, access is granted to Law Enforcement (fully sworn officers, Class I, II, or III special officers, and dispatchers – no auxiliary, or other civilian personnel); Firefighters certified by New Jersey Division of Fire Safety as Level I certified; and Medics and EMTs certified by New Jersey Office of Emergency Services. 
