

Rule changes for 2018

- 7.10e** The formula for calculating unhit target penalties for REVOLVER COMPANY matches was changed, and the penalties were doubled.
- 9.2.1** The number of people on a smoothbore company at National Skirmishes is reduced from five to **four**.
- 12.1** Amended to change the distance of the Smoothbore Pistol individual matches to 12.5 and 25 yards, from the previous 25 and 50.
- 12.2(l)** Adds a Seven-Gun Aggregate, effective with the 139th National Skirmish (May 2019).
- 18.4.2** Coaching during a company match must be done only by a COMPETING member of the company.
- 28.3.4** This was rewritten for clarity. No substantive change.
- Table 28.2b** The table was rewritten using the formula adopted in **rule 7.10e**.
- 31.4.5** Smoothbore B company now pays six places, and smoothbore C company now pays three.
- 37.20.1** Every non-National skirmish at Fort Shenandoah will allow a mandatory two-hour period for lead picking immediately following the end of the skirmish. Shooting may resume after that two-hour period.
