

The goal of Identity Mission is to impact the lives of orphaned, abandoned, and at-risk children by bringing healing to the orphan's heart through sharing the truth that their identity resides in the message of Christ Jesus.

Who we are:

In 2014, Honduran children and family services underwent an enormous change. The institution that had been operating for 20 years was dissolved. A new government entity was created with the plan of utilizing the help that non-profit organizations provide. With this change Identity Mission was born to take advantage of the opportunity to serve the Honduran orphaned children in receiving the best care possible. Research supports that best care focuses on setting the lonely in families. (Psalm 68:6)

Identity Mission is committed to implementing and expanding the use of family-based care for the vulnerable children of Honduras. We are dependent on God's grace and the collaboration of the body of Christ to see the fulfillment of healing for this nation of orphans. We strive to accomplish our part in caring for the fatherless by assisting orphanages with implementing best practices, cultivating the Honduran church and community in establishing family-based care such as foster care and family preservation, and advocating for local adoptions.



What we do:

A. Identity in Christ

After working with children growing up in orphanages for several years, a large realization became apparent: many aged-out and returned to lifestyles of poverty and crime. Across Honduras, hundreds of these young adults struggled with one main impeding factor: their identity. This factor resulted in a continued sense of orphan, not belonging, and having no purpose. All due to the fact that identity is cultivated in a family atmosphere. Therefore our goal is to impact these children with the truth of who they are in Christ through conferences, Life Books, discipleship programs, and other events. Identity Mission desires to help each child realize that through salvation they are no longer orphans but actually sons and daughters of a great Father; adopted into an amazing and quite large family of believers!

The identity message will also be advanced by our efforts for better orphan care solutions that keep these vulnerable children in family environments from the beginning. There, naturally, as God intended, identities will be created; and therefore, belonging and purposes will be provided.

B. Home Care

While seeking reintegration into biological family, foster care, and/or adoption should be the ultimate goal in each child's life, orphanages are often an essential part of orphan care for crisis management. That is why Identity Mission desires to reach the children where they are by walking alongside these residential children's homes to supply for emergency needs, nutritional lack, needed materials, collaboration in building projects, and a network of resources.

C. Alternative Care

It is of extreme importance that we as Christ's hands and feet advocate for the fatherless. That is why Identity Mission chooses to be a voice for domestic and international adoption, as well as foster and kinship care solutions, reintegration of poverty orphans into biological family, and the need for family preservation in poor communities. To implement a foster care program that functions through the local church, Identity mission collaborates with Honduras' family and children welfare services to provide Christian foster family location services, trainings, follow up, and support. In addition, Identity Mission is committed to providing family support through projects and the provision of resources that equip struggling families to care for their children and prevent separation when feasible and safe.
