



A LITURGY FOR LISTENING IN PRAYER

And Jesus said, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear." (Mark 4:9)

What has God told me recently from his Word?
[Selah]

*So we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard,
lest we drift away from it. (Hebrews 2:1)*

What has he spoken before in this sacred space of prayer?
[Selah]

*Let me hear what God the Lord will speak,
for he will speak peace to his people, to his saints. (Psalm 85:8a)*

What do I want to ask him (*not* ask him *for*)?
[Selah]

For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. (Psalm 62:5)

What does he want to say to me right now?
[Begin with a breathing prayer, settle into silence. Listen for the Lord.]

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. (John 10:27)

Lastly, is there anything I want to tell him in response?
[Selah]
