MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR

Time: 1:44 P.M.

Agent McCarthy just telephoned from Niles Center, Illinois, stating that he and Igent Walsh had just located a body at the corner of Long and Niles Avenue, at Niles Center, Illinois. The party is blond and has a small moustache, and answers the description of "Baby Face" Nelson. The body is now at an undertaking establishment at 8057 Niles Center Road. An identification has not yet been made by fingerprints. Agents are leaving immediately with fingerprint equipment for this purpose. Niles Center is about 30 miles from Chicago. The papers are not cognizant of the fact that this body was found; however, Agents McCarthy and Walsh were accompanied by officials of the Niles Center Police Department, which officials are being held there by the Agents so that they will not have an opportunity to give out this information. The lead relative to the possibility of the body being there was furnished by Niles Center officers, who called our Chicago Office. They earlier had found the clothing in that general vicinity, which was bloody, and indicated a number of shots in the body.

Mr. Clegg stated that this may be a "wild guess" but it is the best information they have just now.

I instructed Mr. Clegg to call as soon as he learns whether an identification is made.
