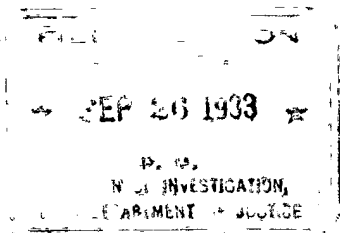

- * Model 28 AC Thompson Submachine Gun, Horizontal Foregrip and Sling Strap, complete with one Type XX 20-cartridge capacity box magazine and with Cutts Compensator attached. The following accessories should also be ordered for this weapon:
 - 4 Type XX 20-cartridge capacity box magazines.
 - 1 Type I, 50-cartridge capacity drum magazine.
 - 1 Gun Carrier case with holster for stock and four pockets for 20-capacity box magazines.
 - 1 Fifty-round drum magazine with shoulder strap.
 - 1 Spare Part Metal Kit Container, complete with: Brush and Thong, Short Handle Breech Cleaning Brush, Extractor, Firing Pin, Firing Pin Spring, Hammer Pin, Sear Spring, Sear Lever Spring, and Trigger Spring.
- 1 Automatic Shot Gun, 12 Gauge, Cylinder Bore, 20" Barrel, to be fired with Duckshot Shell.
- 1 Springfield Sporter Rifle, N.R.A. type .30-'06 calibre, with 20" barrel.
