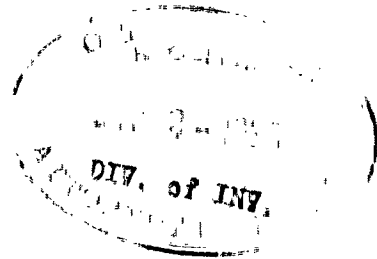

Dear Mr. Attorney General:
