You are advised that the Bureau has made arrangements for the shipment to you this afternoon by air mail from the Auto Ordnance Company, Inc., Hartford, Connecticut, of two Model 28 M3 U. S. - 20 Model 23 A3 Thompson Submachine Guns, Horizontal Foregrip and Sling Strap, complete with one Type XX 20-cartridge capacity box magazine and with Cutts Compensator attached.

The following accessories for each gun should also be ordered:
