Sri Maha Sudarsana Yegyam is a very powerful Homa which fulfills a devotee's desires, removes all obstacles and makes one's mission successful. The Yegya brings health, wealth, peace and prosperity.



Sahasra Kalasabhishekam comprises 3 words, sahasra (thousand), kalasa (pitchers / vessels), and abhishekam (consecration by holy water, liquids and other materials).

In Vedas, Lord Vishnu tells Brahma that propitiation in the form of ablution with 1008 vessels, filled with holy water and other sacred materials, pleases Him (Vishnu) exceedingly. Whoever witnesses Lord Vishnu during this ablution with faith and devotion, obtains the fruits of bathing in the sacred rivers like the Ganges, Godavari, Krishna and Kaveri. The ceremony is equivalent to the great festivals such as Kumbha Mela on the banks of the holy Ganges River.

Maha Raja Gopura Kumbhabhishekam in 2018

Maha Ganapati Temple of Arizona has been home to many firsts in the Southwest. It is the first in the state to be built according to the Agama Shastra - a treatise on the method of worship and temple construction. According to that, a temple gains enormous spiritual energy when it has the gopurams (towers) as these towers receive and concentrate cosmic energy and energize the deities that devotees worship.

Under the guidance of Padmashri.Sri. MuthiahSthapathy, a team of shilpis (temple artisans) will continue to work on completing the monument by mid-2018. Adorned with sculptures and motifs of immense details from Hindu Mythology, the 54-foot Raja Gopuram is estimated to cost over 1,000,000 US Dollars. The consecration of the Raja Gopuram will take place in 2018 and will be a sight to behold!
