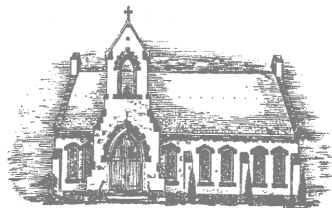
The attendance for **August 13** was 48 and the offering total was \$1,847.00. We thank you for your generosity.
