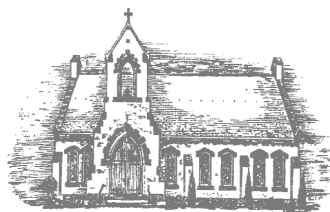
The attendance for **September 17** was 50.
