How to Choose the Best Day to Visit

We want your Student for a Day visit to be as beneficial as possible. Please note the dates available for your Student for a Day visit during our fall and spring semesters.

- **Spring 2018 dates: TBA**

Here are recommended days of the week to visit based on your primary instrument and/or intended major:

- Woodwind/Brass: Wednesday
- Voice: Wednesday
- Piano or Organ: Wednesday or Thursday
- Jazz/Percussion: Thursday

- Prospective Music Education majors: Wednesday or Thursday
- Prospective Music Performance majors: Wednesday or Thursday
- Prospective Music BA majors Wednesday or Thursday

A typical "Music Major for a Day" schedule lasts from 10:00am-5:00pm. It is a full day of music classes, ensembles, lessons, and meetings. A lunch break (with a MHU Music student when possible) will be included in your schedule. Campus tours/admissions meetings can also be scheduled on this date to make the most of your valuable time.
