Concrete Canoe Update

Let the countdown begin! Only eight more weeks until competition! Here are the latest updates from the Concrete Canoe Planning Committee:

Water Safety

As mentioned in Mailer 3, we will do everything we can to race on the day of the event. THE WATER WILL BE COLD! It is the responsibility of each team to ensure the safety of their paddlers in this regard. MSOE will not require paddlers to wear thermal protection (wet suits) while racing. However, it is suggested that your team is equipped with towels, blankets, and an extra set of clothes. In the event that a canoe does capsize and paddlers are exposed to the water, the rescue team will respond quickly and remove paddlers from the water. After this point, teams will be responsible for keeping paddlers safe from the elements. Shelter and heat will be available on site.

All teams are expected to abide by specifications stated in Section 11 - Race Rules and Regulations, namely Section 11.2.5 regarding paddler swimming ability and life jacket requirements.

Academic Submissions - CLARIFICATION

If you're keeping up with CNCCC RFI postings on Facebook, you would have noticed RFI No. 86 - Number and Type of Submittals posted 25 January 2017. The RFI response emphasizes, "*Host schools are not permitted to change the requirements for submitting hard and/or electronics copies of the Design Paper and Project Overview and Technical Addendum.*"

For clarification, our team received full permission from CNCCC to modify submittal requirements for the 2017 GLSC canoe competition. Therefore, please follow the submittal requirements as stated in the Mailer 3 Concrete Canoe section. If you

Again, good luck and continued success to your teams. See you in March!

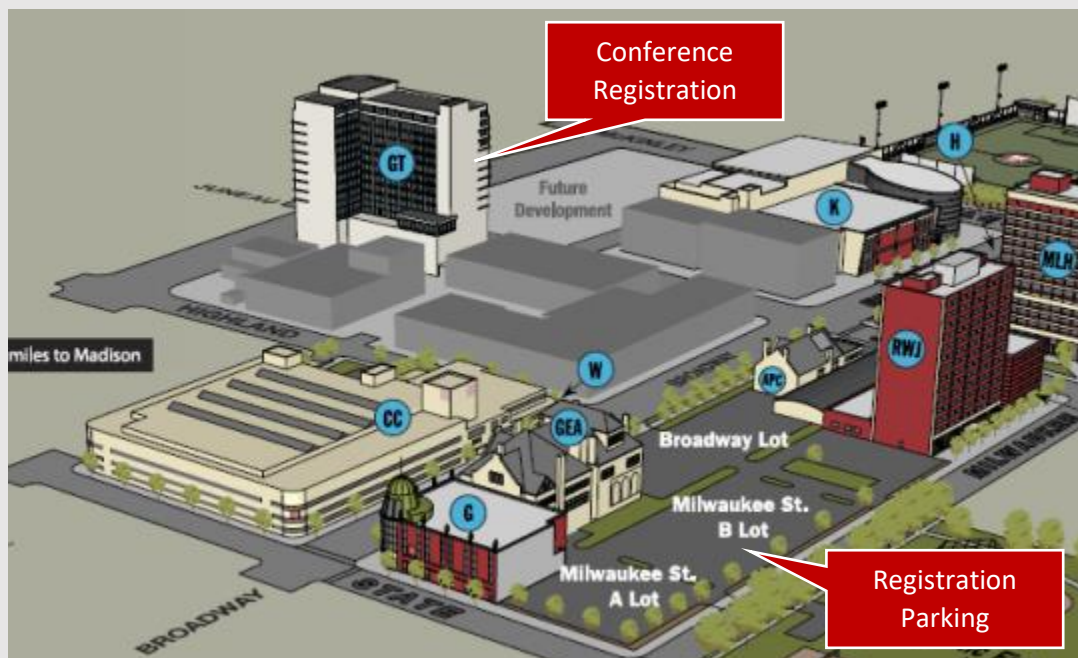

The Milwaukee St. B Lot will be available free of charge for parking when coming to register your school. Local street parking can also be used but please be mindful of parking regulations and fees.

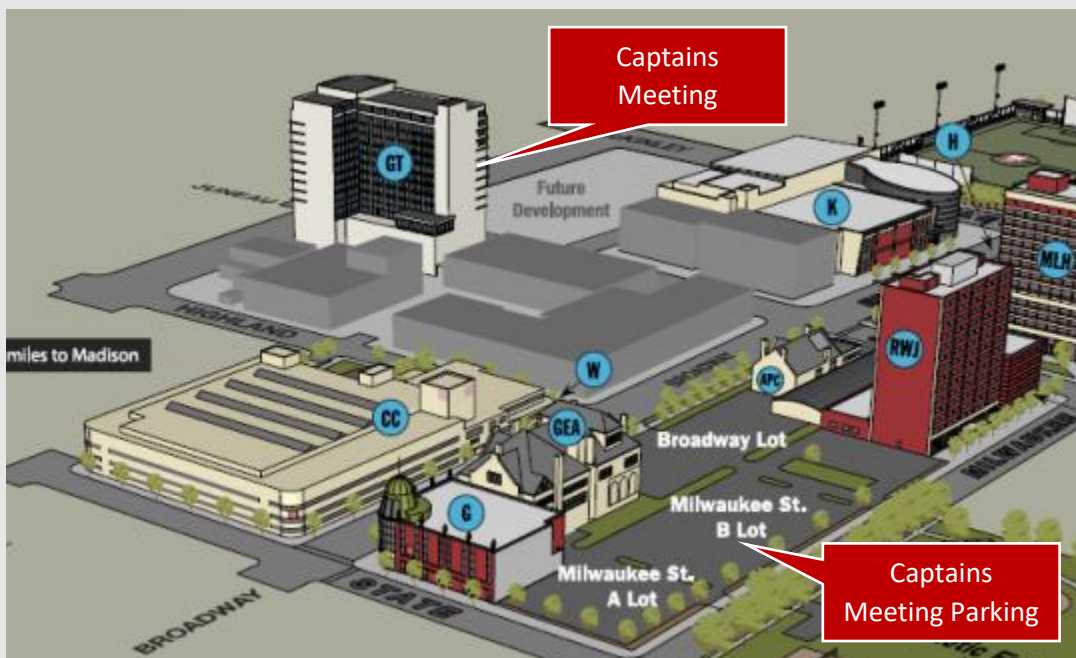


Captains Meeting Information

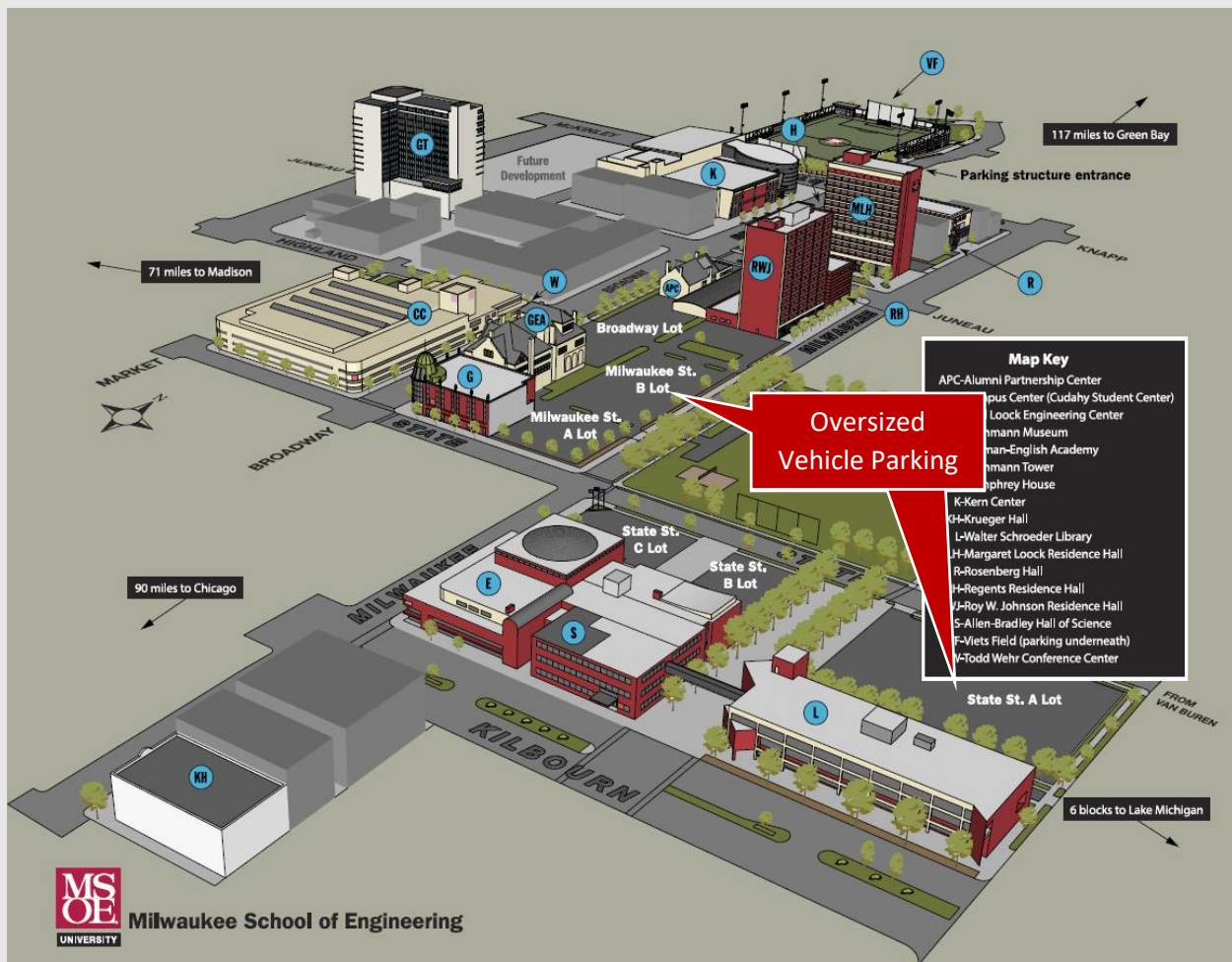

The Milwaukee St. B Lot will be available free of charge for parking when coming to the captains meeting. Local street parking can also be used but please be mindful of parking regulations and fees.



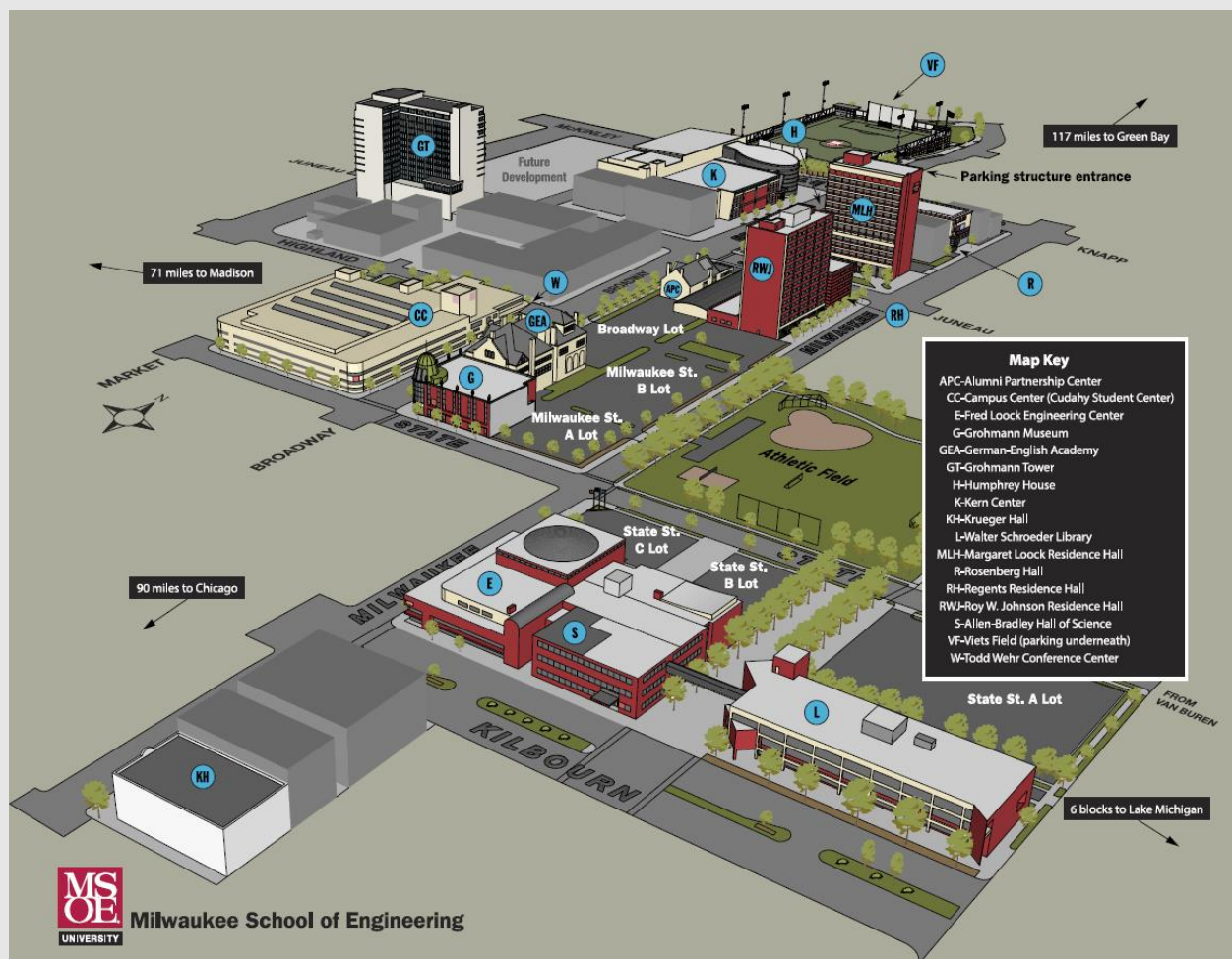
Oversized Vehicle Parking
