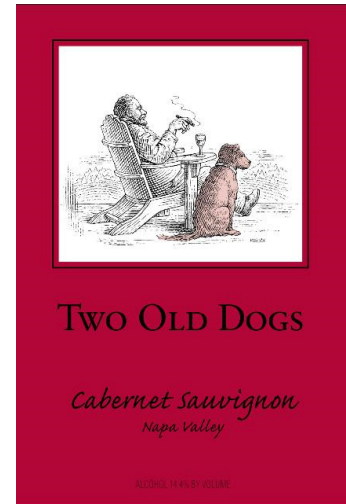


Two Old Dogs 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon

Winemaking Notes

The 2012 Two Old Dogs Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, comes from grapes chosen from the cooler sections of the Herb Lamb Vineyard. Winemaker Michael Trujillo says “This was one of the most balanced crops we’ve seen in several years, with beautifully ripe fruit and great aromatics, making the wine plush, forward and expressive.” This 100% Cabernet wine is a junior version of the HL Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, showing great structure and depth. In the nose, red fruit is highlighted, with spice, cherry and violets. In the mouth, there is a spicy minerality, with pencil shaving, black spices, cocoa, cardamom and mocha. It finishes with flavors of cherry, chocolate truffle and cocoa dust with a hint of cedar.



Vintage Notes

The 2012 growing season in the Napa Valley was perfectly balanced, offering fully-mature grapes that were both fruity and complex. This quality is reflected in the 2012 Two Old Dogs Cabernet, a vintage that is approachable at release with great potential for long-term aging.
