**The Show:**

Niki Berg, a New York freelance photographer, has had one-person shows in New York, New Jersey and Massachusetts and group shows in Florida, Massachusetts, California and New York. She was awarded first prize in the 1982 Berkshire Life Competition. The exhibit is from a series of nude portraits of Berg and her mother. The real concern and universality of these images is the cycle of nurturing, struggle, growth, and separation of two women. The pictures make visible the complexity of the relationship between a grown woman and her mother. They show a present which contains a long personal history seen simultaneously from the view of the mother and daughter. Berg's work is an adventurous exploration, and it suggests a serious task other women might feel the need to undertake.
