



## **KENYA, THE “OUT OF AFRICA” EXPERIENCE**

**13 Days / 12 Nights**

### **SUMMARY:**

Travel dates: Any time of the year - your travel dates are fully customizable, as per your preference

### **DESTINATION HIGHLIGHTS:**

- **Nairobi National Park:** Located approximately 7 km south of the center of Nairobi, this park boasts a large and varied wildlife population, amid wide-open grass plains and a backdrop of city scrapers. It is one of Kenya's most successful rhinoceros sanctuaries, home to the world's densest concentration of black rhinos. Visitors to the park can also visit the Elephant Orphanage run by the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust that rehabilitates orphaned elephant calves.
- **Amboseli National Park:** Amboseli is 39,206 hectares in size at the center of an 8,000 square km ecosystem that spreads across the Kenya-Tanzania border. The park is famous for the Maasai people and for being one of the best places in Africa to get close to free-ranging elephants, giraffe, lion, cheetah, and an enormous amount of birds, all whilst in the shadows of the snow-capped Mt Kilimanjaro, the highest free-standing mountain in the world.
- **Ol Pejeta Conservancy:** Resting at the foothills of Mount Kenya and the Aberdare Mountain Range, the Ol Pejeta Conservancy is the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. It is also home to the last three remaining northern white rhino in the world. Ol Pejeta provides a sanctuary for rescued chimpanzees, and is home to the renowned 'Big Five' as well as a wide range of other African animals including: zebra, giraffe, hippo, cheetah, jackal, serval, hyena, vervet monkey and many more. Visitors can enjoy an assortment of activities such as horse rides, game walks, and nocturnal game drives.
- **Maasai Mara National Reserve:** Kenya's Maasai Mara together with Tanzania's Serengeti form Africa's most famous wildlife area. The annual wildebeest migration through the Serengeti and the Maasai Mara is the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. But that is not where the game viewing ends; large prides of lions, elephants and giraffes in grasslands, gazelles and eland to mention but a few. Aside from traditional vehicle safaris, game walks and hot-air ballooning over the Mara plains has become almost essential.





## **DAY BY DAY ITINERARY:**

- Day 1: You will depart from your home airport in the U.S. Africa is waiting to give you its unique, warm welcome. Karibuni sana, marafiki zetu!
- Day 2: You will be en route to Kenya.
- Day 3: Upon arrival, you will be met at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport by your Certified English-speaking driver / wildlife guide. You will be escorted to your 4X4 Land Cruiser safari vehicle and transferred to your accommodation in or near Nairobi National Park. Overnight in Nairobi. Meals included: All meals.
- Day 4: In the early morning, you will experience your first wildlife safari game drive in Nairobi National Park. Then, after breakfast, you will be taken for a visit at the Giraffe Center as well as the David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage. Overnight in Nairobi. Meals included: All meals.
- Day 5: In the morning, you will be met by our driver and transferred to Wilson Airport where you will board your flight to Amboseli National Park. On arrival on Amboseli, your driver / wildlife guide will meet you and transfer you to the camp where you will be spending two nights exploring this park that is located on the foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro. Overnight in Amboseli National Park. Meals included: All meals.
- Day 6: You will have a full day of wildlife safaris in Amboseli. Overnight in Amboseli National Park. Meals included: All meals.
- Day 7: After a morning game drive and breakfast, your driver/guide will transfer you to Amboseli Airstrip where you will board your flight to Wilson Airport. In Nairobi Wilson Airport, you will connect to your flight to Nanyuki. Upon arriving, a representative will meet you and take you to the camp where you will be spending two nights. You will enjoy a game drive on the way from the airport to your camp. Overnight in Ol Pejeta. Meals included: All meals.
- Day 8: You will have a full day of safaris in Ol Pejeta – including a visit to the Chimpanzee Rescue Center and the Rhino Sanctuary. Overnight in Ol Pejeta. Meals included: All meals.
- Day 9: After breakfast at your camp, you will be transferred to Nanyuki Airstrip where you will board your flight to Maasai Mara National Reserve. Once you arrive, you will be met and transferred to the camp where you will spend three nights exploring this amazing and iconic place of stunning landscapes and incredible amount of wildlife. Overnight in Maasai Mara. Meals included: All meals.
- Days 10 and 11: Two full days of wildlife experiences and safari drives in Maasai Mara. Optional activities such as a Hot Air Balloon safari (where you will see the Maasai Mara from the air, in a hot air balloon) and a Bush Breakfast (breakfast in the middle of the savannah) can be arranged at extra cost. Overnight in Maasai Mara. Meals included: All meals.





- Day 12: After breakfast at your hotel, you will be transferred to a nearby airstrip for your flight to Nairobi, where you will connect to your onward flight back home.
- Day 13: You will arrive in the U.S. after a trip of a lifetime – with beautiful photographs, amazing video clips, and of course unforgettable memories!
