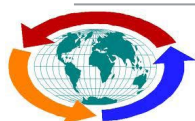

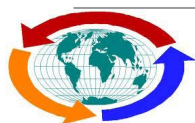

Battery Park dock and the picnic area known as Wagner Park North, in Battery Park City, is served by most subway lines and is easily assessable by taxi:

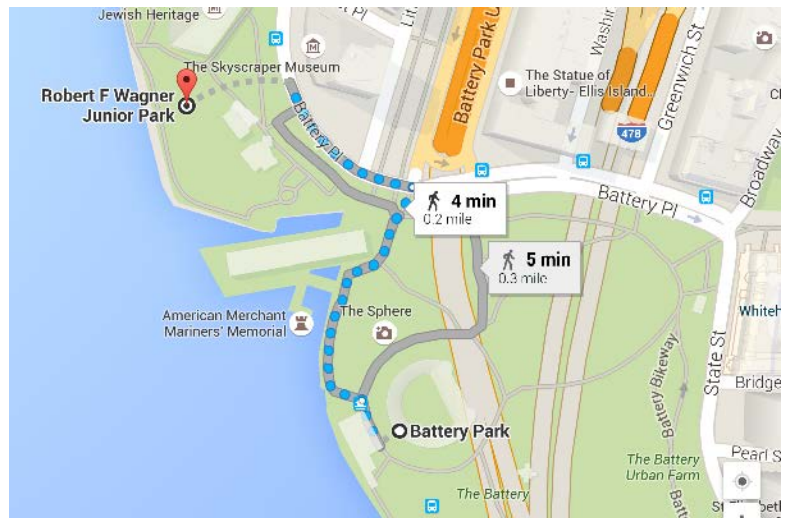
