Fabric and Notions Requirements

1 Fat Quarter for the Exterior of the wallet (or 1/4 yard)

1 Fat Quarter for the Lining of the wallet (or 1/4 yard)

1/2 yd fabric for the pockets and credit card slots (or if you want you can get 2 coordinating fabrics, 1/4 yd each, one for the credit card pockets and one for the zippered pockets)

1 yard Fusible backing 45" wide (I used Pellon Decor 809*)

1/4 yard Pellon Peltex*

Turn Lock Closure or one set purse magnets

9 inch zipper with nylon teeth* (or 2 if you want 2 pockets)

If you want to add a wristlet or "across the body" strap, you will need 1 package of 1/2 inch D rings* and a package of swivel hooks.*

These items are available in the store.

This pattern is NOT WRITTEN FOR DIRECTIONAL FABRIC!

Sewing Machine

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Bring power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine

Required Feet/Accessories/Needles

1/4 inch seam foot Edge foot (Bernina 10D) optional Zipper foot

Threads:

Sewing thread to match all fabrics

General Sewing Supplies

Marking pen or chalk pencil (for fabric)
Rotary cutter, mat, and large ruler
Scissors
Straight pins
Jeans or Denim needle
Wonder clips
Turning tool/ chopstick
Frey Check
Stiletto

Misc. Items

Pen, pencil and paper for making notes Sack Lunch and Drink

Pre-Class Instructions

Cutting and Fusing Instructions: (do prior to coming to class)

1) Piece D (the large oval piece)

Cut 1 piece from the main fabric

Cut 1 piece from the lining fabric

Cut 2 pieces from the Decor Bond 809 and fuse to the wrong sides of the main fabric piece and the lining piece

2) Piece A (the front flap)

Cut 1 from the main fabric

Cut 1 from the lining fabric

Cut 2 pieces from the Decor Bond 809 and fuse to the wrong sides of the main fabric piece and the lining piece

3) Piece C (the border for the flap)

Cut one piece from the peltex and cut as accurately as possible.

Save the center part of the peltex and bring to class. This will be used in the flap.

4) Piece B (Flap Fabric Border)

Cut 2 of these pieces from fabric, and then fuse the Peltex Piece C to the center of one of these pieces. (The pattern says to cut one piece, but I will be showing an alternate method of applying this border so you do not need to use glue or Wonder tape.)

5) Zipper Pockets

If you want 1 pocket:

Cut 2 rectangles 8 inches by 4 inches (this is used for the lining of the pocket, no Decor Bond used on these pieces)

Cut 2 rectangles 8 inches by 7 1/2 inches from fabric and 2 from Decor Bond. Fuse.

Cut 2 pieces 2 1/2 by 2 1/2 (for zipper tabs)

If you want 2 pockets

Cut 1 piece 7 1/2 inches by 8 inches for outer pocket and 1 of Decor Bond. Fuse

Cut 2 pieces 41/2 inches by 8 inches for outer pocket and 2 of Decor Bond. Fuse

Cut 4 pieces 2 12 by 2 1/2 inches for zipper tabs

Cut 4 pieces 4 inches by 8 inches for lining of pockets

6) Credit card Slots

Cut 2 Rectangles 8 inches by 17 inches from fabric

Cut 2 Rectangles 8 inches by 17 inches from Decor Bond 809

Cut 1 Rectangle 8 inches by 8.5 inches from fabric

Cut 1 Rectangle 8 inches by 8.5 inches from Decor Bond 809

Fuse the Decor Bond 809 to these 3 fabric pieces

On the back of the fused 8 inch X 17 inch pieces of fabric for the credit card slots, using a pencil, mark the fold lines as shown in the picture on page 3 at the bottom (Step 4)

Don't forget to bring your lunch and beverages.
