RESOLUTION REGARDING THE DOMINION TRANSMISSION, INC., PROPOSED "NEW MARKET PROJECT" (FERC DOCKET NO. CP14-497-000)

WHEREAS, Dominion Transmission, Inc. wishes to increase the capacity of its gas pipeline in New York State and significantly expand the horsepower of its compressor station at Brookman Corners as part of its New Market Project; and

WHEREAS, the Brookman Corners facility as proposed could produce nearly twice the emissions of the compressor stations planned by Dominion in Madison and Chemung counties, as well as much higher levels of pollutants dangerous to human health, including nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, volatile organic compounds, and formaldehyde; and


WHEREAS, two scoping meetings have been held in Madison County and none have been scheduled in the vicinity of the Brookman Corners site, thereby depriving residents of our town who are the most affected by the proposed project, including Amish who are unable to travel great distances without significant inconvenience, of an opportunity to address FERC staff in person;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Minden, in view of the scope of Dominion's proposed project and the potential for it to negatively impact the residents of our town, requests that:

1. FERC schedule a scoping meeting in the Town of Minden and that it reopen the comment period so that all of the residents of the town have an equal and reasonable opportunity to be heard with regard to their questions and concerns,
2. FERC prepare a full Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) so that all issues and factors can be thoroughly evaluated and that if deemed appropriate that a design be developed for the compressor station for the Brookman Corners site that will not negatively impact the residents of the Town of Minden.
