Chapter Education Award

1. This is a **chapter** award to be given to the chapter that has had the most CEU's and diverse education programs May 2017- March 4th, 2018..
2. Programs competing for this award must fall in categories on clinical education, administrative education, or general education for improving knowledge, techniques, and skills related to the practice of Medical Assisting. Only those program that have been granted approval by the AAMA continuing education department shall be considered for this award.
3. To be eligible the chapter should submit CEU approval number with approved category (administrative, clinical, or general).
4. Submit objectives of program content for each program.
5. Point System for judging:
 - a. 5 points per CEU approved hour
 - b. Up to 10 points for diversity
 - c. 5 BONUS points to the chapter who host a seminar, convention, or workshop. This bonus is to be awarded once.
6. Nominations must be received by the Awards Committee Chair, Mistie Atkins, CMA (AAMA), no later than March 4th, 2018.
