Netherlands first with MedEye

The Dutch-Icelandic start-up MedEye has its first full-hospital customer for its medication safety system. Deventer Hospital was first. The young company expects to start soon with additional academic hospitals in the Netherlands. MedEye is designed to prevent medication errors in hospitals. The system examines the dose and indicates whether it is correct. Checks are done at the bedside. Deventer Hospital first started testing the solution in August of last year. The system not only prevents incorrect doses, but also ensures that all the administered medications are recorded directly in the medical patient record.
