Short Description of Role:

We are looking for teachable and flexible individuals who have a love for serving others and an interest in international business and teaching English as a basis for relationship building.

Due to the nature of the internship, situations may arise where you will be asked to assist in other areas of need. We ask that you be flexible and be willing to serve where needed.

Responsibilities:

This position would include working in a cafe setting in food preparation and customer service. You will also gain some experience in international business and restaurant management. The position would also include teaching ESL to adults and/or children. Although curriculum will be provided, creativity and flexibility is desired in the classroom. You will be expected to work in a team environment, participate in team meetings, and build relationships as opportunities arise. In total these commitments would equal 30-35 hours/week. The opportunity to study the local Arabic dialect, or French if preferred, is provided. We have secured local tutors experienced in teaching language. Though not required, language study will give you a better opportunity to communicate while in country.

Qualifications:

- Interest in overseas living and willingness to work in a cafe
- Experience in teaching (preferred but not mandatory)

Compensation:

The intern would be required to raise funds for this position. Here's what's to expect:

1. Airfare (approx. \$1000-\$2000)
2. Personal insurance (required) – price varies
3. In-country costs: 3 month internship - \$2,700
6 month internship - \$5,600
12 month internship - \$11,200

24 month internship - \$22,400

4. Visa Trip: Required every 4 months. Approx. \$500 each – Only for interns staying longer than 4 months.

You will live in our intern housing where you will be responsible for your own cooking and cleaning. Most modern conveniences are available. The city is located between the desert and the sea. It is a coastal city. There are many interesting day trips or weekend excursions from the capital. There is an international airport with connections to many major European cities.
