#### **Short Description of Role:**

OneStory Quest is an adventure that will change your life and bring life-giving good news to a people group, most of who have not heard God's Word in their language. Because they do not yet have the Bible in their language, the majority of them do not understand that it is for them too. You will be part of a small dynamic team that will be based in Pointe-Noire, Congo and travel to villages where life is difficult and tenuous. You will use up-to-date equipment to help create a Bible Story Set for these people. In approximately two years, you can produce a tool that will present Jesus to those Vili who would otherwise have no opportunity to learn of Him. This Bible Story Set will be a legacy that will remain long after your adventure is complete.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Learn the Kituba or Vili language and culture
- Work together with a team to learn the OneStory approach to story crafting
- Work together with Kituba or Vili speakers to develop a redemptive chronological story set of 25-40 stories
- Record and archive the stories
- Work with local workers to teach native speakers to establish story groups and share the stories

#### **Qualifications:**

You don't need any previous translation experience or linguistic training, but you will need the ability to learn languages. Basic French is a definite plus, but if you don't have that, we will arrange for a short "Survival French" course before you start studying the language you'll be working in.

You also need the ability to use a computer and learn new software programs with instruction Very good to excellent physical and mental health. Adaptability to rugged physical conditions and uncertain diet.
