

## WHO WE ARE



In 1989, Greg Von Tobel began Prisoners For Christ Outreach Ministries. PFC has continued to expand ministries to prisoners and their families seeing millions come to Christ since our inception.

In 2005, the Holy Spirit gave Greg a number of 1,000,000 inmates coming to PFC-sponsored church services and Bible studies within 10 years – by 2016. **That number was met in 2013 with 1.17 million prisoners attending PFC services that year alone!** Now that's proof positive that God watches over His Word to perform it. Even more amazing is that more than **360,000 inmates decided to follow Christ for the first time in that year alone!** Where else but in the kingdom of God would you receive that level of return on an investment in a down economy?

In addition to our front line ministries in the jails and prisons, the Lord continues to use our **Bible Study Correspondence School** and our national inmate newspaper (**Yard Out**) to dramatically impact the lives of inmates who receive these resources. We regularly receive letters of thanksgiving from inmates who are involved in the Bible Studies or who have read our newspaper. Over 2,600 inmates are currently enrolled in correspondence studies across the nation.

Over the last few years, the Lord has opened up the door for PFC to take our resources abroad to further equip foreign nationals in developing prison ministries. Facilitating this expansion, we have opened field offices in 14 countries on 3 continents: Africa, Asia and North America. The leadership of PFC has a broad vision and the Lord is growing the ministry every day.

## OUR MISSION

Prisoners For Christ Outreach Ministries is dedicated to taking the Gospel of Jesus Christ into the jails, prisons and juvenile centers in the Northwest, across the United States and around the world. We accomplish this task through worship services, Bible studies, special concerts and one-to-one visitations.

(*Titus 1:5-9; 1 Tim 3:1; 1 Tim 5:17; Acts 20:28*) The purpose of the church on earth is to fulfill the last command of Jesus. (*Matt. 28:18-20*) Christians are endowed with spiritual gifts which enable them to minister in the church. (*Eph. 4:11*) The Holy Spirit, whom every believer receives at conversion leads and guides us. (*Eph. 1:13-14; Rom 8:14*) In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling, the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life and in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus. (*Gal 5:22-25; 1 Cor 6:19; Rom 15:5; Eph 4:3*)
