The Rules of the Journey

1. The city where the Ark resides is called the 'Giving City'. The city that receives the Ark is called the 'Receiving City'.
2. It is the responsibility of the Giving City to find a Receiving City.
3. The Receiving City determines its symbolic centre where the Ark will reside.
4. The Giving City transports the Ark in a horizontal position to the symbolic centre of the Receiving City and installs the Ark in such a way that its presentation is honourable and secure.
5. The Receiving City develops a ritual of interpretation to ensure that the Ten Sustainable Commandments will be taken up by as many inhabitants as possible.
6. The Receiving City ensures that the different interpretations of the Ten Sustainable Commandments will be spread among as many inhabitants as possible so that a conversation about a new, sustainable culture is initiated.
7. When the Receiving City sincerely believes that the interpretations are sufficiently disseminated, the city deserves the right to add its own city name on the Ark in script no larger than the script of other Giving Cities.
8. After the city has added its name to the Ark, the Receiving City becomes a Giving City and Rule 1 must now be enforced. This cycle will continue until the Ark has finished its forty year Journey, which commenced on June 14, 2017. In this case, Rule 9 comes into effect.
9. The Last Receiving City builds a solid temple to seal the Ark of the Newest Covenant.
