Available spaces at this event are 8'w x 6'd or smaller. 8'x6' spaces will start at \$165, smaller spaces will vary between \$100-\$145 by location. Electricity will be available for \$15, table rental will be available for \$20/each.

Application Process Schedule

September 2nd through September 30th -applications available

September 30th -application deadline

October 5th -notifications emailed

October 19th -space fee payment due for accepted applications

November 15th -last day for refunds

Invited applicants can secure their spaces by credit card/PayPal. We no longer accept checks. If accepted as a seller, your space fee payment will be due no later than October 19th, 2015. This application must be complete and received by September 30th, 2015 to be considered. No late applications will be taken.

An email will be sent to the email address you supply on your application by October 5th, 2015 to notify you whether or not your application has been accepted to the Market. Please add Eileen@ClevelandHandmade.com and Kathy@ClevelandHandmade.com to your email's address book and/or whitelist so that our messages to you are not delayed. We cannot be responsible for lost emails or delayed notifications. Please add us to your address book and check your spam folder if you haven't received a notification from us by the end of the day October 5th.

Day of Show

Load-in will begin the evening before and at 7am on the morning of the show. The Market will begin at 10am and remain open until 6pm. Tear-down and load-out begins at 6pm and should be complete before 8pm. Freight elevators and passenger escalators will be available during load-in and load-out (unless there are circumstances beyond our control) for all floors.

*Setting-up the day before the show will be available on Friday, December 19th, time to be determined.

Space Sharing

Again this year, spaces may NOT be shared. Should you wish to be placed near a friend, we'll likely be able to arrange you together if you are both invited to participate.

Sales

Sellers will be responsible for all of their sales and remittance of applicable Cuyahoga county sales tax. Sellers should be ready with change for cash sales and credit card acceptance devices if desired. Wi-Fi is likely not available in the building, so wireless devices will need to be able to use cellular networks (3G or 4G, for example).

All work for sale should be priced and marked ahead of time.

No commission is taken on sales at the show.

Refunds

If inclement weather, another unpredictable event, or an order from the government forces us to cancel or delay the Market, we cannot offer any refunds after November 15th, 2015. If your application is accepted and you have made your space fee payment but need to cancel your participation in the Market, you must contact Eileen Segura Eileen@ClevelandHandmade.com by November 15th, 2015. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER NOVEMBER 15th, 2015.** After November 15th, 2015, we will work with you to our best ability to sell your space to someone on the waiting list, but we cannot guarantee that it will be possible.

-This show's application process has historically been competitive and we have had to turn away even the nicest, coolest, most talented people because their jury scores were even just slightly lower than someone else's. Even best friends, family members, and world-renowned artists have been turned away.

This is especially true in the jewelry category where we have usually had at least 4 applications for every available spot.

-It is possible that your application may not be invited to participate. This part of the process is often heartbreaking for both the applicants AND show producers. If you feel like the possibility of not being invited to participate might be too much to handle in a professional way, please do not apply.

-On OCTOBER 5th everyone will receive an email, at the email address listed on their application, which will indicate their application's status: Invited, Wait-List, or Not Invited.

-On OCTOBER 5th those applications who were invited will be able to buy their preferred space location and size. this is first-come, first-served and the larger, floor 1 spots often sell-out quickly so please be sure you have added Eileen@ClevelandHandmade.com and Kathy@ClevelandHandmade.com to your email's address book and/or whitelist so our messages to you are not delayed.

-Participation in this event is at your own your risk and you are also responsible for any damage or injury caused by you or your property. We strongly recommend that you carry your own liability insurance.
