## A Proclamation

- WHEREAS the Indians of Norridgewock, Arresaguntacook, Weweenock and St. John's Tribes, and the Indians of other Tribes inhabiting in the Eastern and Northern Parts of His Majesty's Territories of New-England, the Penobscot Tribe only excepted, have, contrary to their solemn Submission unto His Majesty long since made and frequently renewed, been guilty of the most perfidious, barbarous and inhuman Murders of divers [sic] of his Majesty's English Subjects for many Months past; and the said Indians have fully discovered an inimical, traiterious and rebellious Intention and Disposition;
- I have therefore thought fit to issue this proclamation, and to Declare the Indians of the Norridgewock, Arresaguntacook, Weweenock and St. John's Tribes, and the Indians of other Tribes inhabiting in the Eastern and Northern Parts of His Majesty's Territories of New-England...to be Enemies, Rebels and Traitors to his Most Sacred Majesty: And I do hereby require his Majesty's Subjects of this Province to embrace all Opportunities of pursuing, captivating, killing and destroying all and every of the aforesaid Indians, the Penobscots excepted....
- ...I do hereby promise, That there shall be paid out of the Province's Treasury to all and any of the said forces, over and above their Bounty upon Enlistment, their villages and subsistence, the Premiums of Bounties following, viz.
- For every Male Indian Prisoner above the Age of Twelve Years, that shall be taken and brought to Boston, Fifty Pounds.
- For every Male Indian Scalp, brought in as Evidence of their being killed, Forty Pounds.
- For every Female Indian Prisoner, taken and brought in as aforesaid, and for every Male Indian Prisoner under the Age of Twelve Years, taken and brought in as aforesaid, Twenty-five Pounds.
- For every Scalp of such Female Indian or Male Indian under Twelve Years of Age, brought as Evidence of their being killed, as aforesaid, Twenty Pounds.
- GIVEN under my Hand at Boston, in the Province aforesaid, this Twelfth Day of June, 1755, and in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Second, by the Grace of GOD, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, etc.

## PROCLAMATION.



HEREAS the Indians of Norridgework, Arrelagum a sok, Wewsenock and St. John's Tribes, and the Indians of the other Tribes inhabiting in the Eaftern and Northern Parts of His Majefty's Territories of New-England, the Penshfor Tribe only excepted, have, contrary to their foleron Submittion unto His Majefty long fince made and frequently renewed, been guilty of the most perfidious, barbarous and inhuman Murders of divers of his Majefty's English Subjects; and have abstained from all Commerce and Correspondence with His Majefty's faid Subjects for many Months past; and the said Indians have fully discovered an inimical, traiterious and rebellious Intention and Disposition;

Dabe therefore thought fit to issue this Proclamation, and to Declare the Indians of the Noridgewock, Arrefaguntacook, Wewcenock and St. John's Tethes, and the Indians of the other Arrives new elect inhabiting in the Eastern and Louthren parts of his Wajesty's Territoites of New-England, and in Alicance and Consideracy with the above-recited Tribes, the Penobless only excepted, to be erromics. Revels and Traitois to his Host Sancted Majesty: And I do hereby require his Majesty's autjeds of this Probince to embrace all Opportunities of pursuing, captivating, killing and bedroying all and any of the assistant, the Penobless recepted.

AND WHEREAS the General Court of this Province have voted, That a Bounty or Encouragement be granted and allowed to be paid out of the Publick-Treasury to the marching Army that shall be employed for the Defence of the Eastern and Western Frontiers from the Twenty-sith of this Month of June until the Twenty-sith of November next;

I have thought be to publish the fame; and I do hereby promife, That there shall be paid out of the Probince-Arcasury to all and any of the said Forces, over and above their Bounty upon Enlishment, their Wages and Sublishence, the Premiums of Bounties following, viz.

For every Male Indian Prifoner above the Age of Twelve Years, that shall be taken and brought to Boston, Fifty Pounds. For every Male Indian Scalp, brought in as Evidence of their being killed, Farty Pounds.

For every Female Indian Prifoner, taken and brought in as aforefaid, and for every Male Indian Prifoner under the Age of Twelve Years, taken and brought in as aforefaid, Twenty-free Pounds.

For every Scalp of such Fernale Indian or Male Indian under Twelve Years of Age, brought as Evidence of their being killed, as aforefaild, Twenty Pounds.

GIVEN under my Head at Bolton, in the Province of origid, this Twelfth Day of June, 1755, and in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lard GEORGE the Seemd, by the Grane of GOD, of Great-Bittain, France, and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, Sec.
