Timing of staff raises – there are four options, 1. Make no change and give back pay after the budget is approved in January; 2. Begin pay increase January 1<sup>st</sup> and then approve the increase at the Annual Meeting; 3. Move the start of the pay cycle later in the year such as March 1<sup>st</sup>; 4. Present and approve an annual budget at the October Congregational Meeting. The consensus of the Church Council is to make no change in the timing of staff raises.

Motion/Second/Carried to make no change to the timing of staff pay raises and to give the Personnel Committee oversight of the process.

There was a discussion on giving some financial assistance to Roseville Lutheran Church to help with the cost of the Loaves and Fishes meal. Their cost is around \$675 each month. Our cost for providing cookies is around \$100. The Outreach Committee will discuss this further.

## Building and Grounds met April 8th.

Montessori has received a grant to be used in their classroom. With part of the money they would like to put new flooring over the tile in the kitchen area of the room. Building and Grounds think we should approve that request with these stipulations: Montessori would pay the full cost of the flooring with the guarantee that if they no longer rented the space we would pro rate the cost of the flooring and reimburse Montessori for the remainder of the cost. We may want to set a time limit on that reimbursement. Resurrection would not pay any of the upfront cost but would consider not raising rent for a year to help Montessori.

Also with Montessori, we will install a small water heater that will heat the water in the Montessori bathroom. We will then ask Montessori to use that bathroom rather than our two by the Fireside Room.
