Job Description: Dining Services Staff

Position Purpose:

Assist the director of dining services in providing nutritious, well-prepared meals using fresh, local ingredients in a hospitable atmosphere for guests and staff.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Assist in the daily operations of the conference center's food service.
2. Serve guests in a friendly manner.
3. Assist in routine sanitation of the kitchen and related equipment.
4. Understand and commit to Gravatt's food philosophy.
5. Work as a member of a food service team.

Other Job Duties: Maintain cleanliness in dining hall, porch and bathrooms and wash kitchen-related laundry. Complete other duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Must be at least 14 years old; however, ages 18 and up are preferred. Experience in institutional or large food service setting is preferred.

Equipment Used: Industrial stove, oven, convection oven, mixer, sink, dishwasher, refrigerator, freezer, microwave, sharp knives and utensils, cleaning chemicals, etc.

Physical Aspects of the Position: Ability to communicate and work with and provide necessary instruction to guests and staff. Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the kitchen. Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid. Requires endurance including prolonged standing, some bending, stooping, and stretching. Requires eye-hand coordination and manual dexterity to manipulate kitchen equipment. Ability to lift 50 pounds. Willing to work irregular hours.

Hours: We serve guests seven days a week for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Schedules are provided one week in advance. This is a part-time position involving irregular hours based on the needs of our guests. It is important that applicants understand that they cannot count on a certain number of hours per week.
