1 **Preliminary Injunction**

2 Defendants and their officers, agents, employees, representatives, affiliates, and all persons  
3 acting in concert or participating with them, are enjoined through November 8, 2022, from prohibiting  
4 or interfering with Plaintiffs and members of the public participating solely in the activities at the Grove  
5 described below in opposition to Rick Caruso’s mayoral campaign on differential terms or treatment  
6 than Defendants apply to expressive activity in support of Rick Caruso’s mayoral campaign, subject to  
7 Defendants’ enforcement of the Grove’s regulations of the time, place, and manner of such expressive  
8 activity that do not conflict with the provisions below:


- 9 • The enjoined parties shall not prohibit or interfere with one stationary protest organized by  
10 Plaintiffs of no longer than an hour in duration that will take place on a Thursday at 3:00 p.m., no  
11 earlier than October 6, 2022 and before November 8, 2022;
- 12 • The stationary protest shall not involve more than 30 people;
- 13 • The stationary protest shall take place in a designated area immediately east of the Grove’s angel  
14 statue where there is no curb and not in the walkway towards the clock on Bow Street;
- 15 • The enjoined parties will not prohibit the protesters from holding signs or chanting but may  
16 prohibit the use of amplified sound;
- 17 • The enjoined parties will not prohibit the protesters from leafletting within the designated  
18 stationary protest area;
- 19 • The enjoined parties are prohibited from sectioning off the designated stationary protest area  
20 with metal barricades or similar enclosure, but the designated stationary protest area may have  
21 “velvet ropes” separating that area from the pedestrian walkways but not the area opening  
22 towards the fountain;
- 23 • Apart from the stationary protest, the enjoined parties shall not prohibit or interfere with any  
24 single individual displaying a paper sign that is not larger than 24” x 36” with messaging that  
25 opposes Caruso’s mayoral candidacy, for up to an hour per day, commencing no earlier than  
26 October 6, 2022.
