Lay Hong to donate 10 sen from sales of every Nutriplus eggs packet for Tabung Harapan

KUALA LUMPUR: Lay Hong Bhd will contribute 10 sen from every packet of Nutriplus eggs sold for Tabung Harapan Malaysia to help ease the country's debts.

Lay Hong group executive director Yap Chor How said it was optimistic that the one-month campaign would encourage more corporates to support the new government's initiative in creating a better future for the nation.

Yap said in a statement it was its duty and obligation to contribute in a fiscally responsible way to help the government tackle its debt woes.

In its recently-announced year ended March 31 2018, Lay Hong's net profit more than doubled to RM37.7 million from RM18.26 million, while revenue increased 24.3 per cent to RM840.4 million from RM675.96 million in the previous year.

According to the Finance Ministry, as of 3pm today, Tabung Harapan Malaysia's collection stood at RM18.61 million as of 3pm today. This was 163 per cent increase over the RM7.07 million on
