## **Class Descriptions**

NWHA Rules will be followed according to the NWHA Rule book. TWHBEA Versatility Rules in effect for applicable classes.

**ADP** – All Day Pleasure

**CP** – Country Pleasure – TWH

**TP** – Trail Pleasure - TWH

LS - Lite Shod - TWH

PLS - Park Lite Shod - TWH

AOT - Amateur Owned & Trained

OT – Optional Tack (Western, English or breed specific, but not a combination)

Minnesota Bred – Any TWH born in Minnesota.

**OGB** – Open Gaited Breed Any Gaited Breed is eligible to enter. Traditional tack and attire appropriate to the breed may be used, but not a combination. Horses enter the ring at the walk specific to the breed. The walk is of the exhibitor's choice, but shall be the walk specific to the breed. The working walk is a slow even four beat walk. The head and neck are lowered as the horse stretches into the rider's hand showing relaxation and acceptance of the bit. At the working walk the horse is calm and relaxed. There is no need for restraint on the part of the rider and there is observable slack in the reins. The intermediate gait is of the exhibitor's choice, shall be the gait the breed considers the intermediate gait. The canter or lope is a three beat gait on the correct lead. The horse is under control.

Novice Horse – Horse not to have won 3 blue ribbons.

Novice Rider – Rider not to have won 3 blue ribbons.

#### **Fun Classes**

All the Fun Classes are open to all gaited breeds

**Costume Class** – Horses may be led or ridden, may have more than one person with the entry. Walk and line up, audience participation in judging.

**Licorice Race** – teams of two and timed, #1 rider holds red licorice piece in mouth, races down to team mate, passes licorice to rider #2 without using hands, Rider #2 races back to start line.

**Magazine Race** – timed individual rider, page # called out, rider races down to magazine, jumps off horse, finds page # & rips it out, jumps back on horse and races back to start line.

**Underwear Race** – teams of two riders and one horse are timed, rider #1 at starting line picks up and puts on boxers, jumps on horse, races to other end, jumps off, removes boxers. Rider #2 puts boxers on, jumps on horse and races back to start line.

**Crepe Paper Pairs** – teams of two riders, each holding an end of a piece of crepe paper ribbon (about 3 foot long). All teams ride around the arena at the call of the announcer (walk, gait, stop, backup, turn – NO CANTER). The last team still connected by an intact piece of ribbon wins.

**Open Egg & Spoon** – Eggs to be balanced on teaspoons. Spoons held with one hand with no fingers to balance the egg. Horses are to be shown at gaits specified by the judge. Last rider holding their egg wins the class.

Barrels & Pole Bending – per TWHBEA Versatility Rules

**Egg Stomp** – timed event, individual riders line up mounted at a starting line across one end of the arena. One egg for each rider will be at the opposite end of arena, in front of you. At the start command, run straight to your egg and get your horse to stomp on it. When egg is stomped, run back to your spot at the starting line. Fastest time wins.

**Ride-A-Buck** – \$ bill will be placed between the rider's leg and the saddle. Horses are to be shown at gaits specified by the judge. Last rider with the \$ between their leg and the saddle is the winner.

Waterglass – per TWHBEA Versatility Rules

### Apparel & Tack Not a combination of English, Western, & Other

English apparel and tack for English classes per the NWHA rulebook and Western apparel and tack for Western classes. Breed-specific apparel and tack in OGB classes.

Trail Obstacle – English or Western apparel and tack or breed-specific.

Casual attire is permitted for fun classes.
