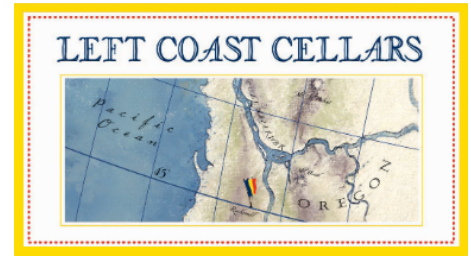

- The Left Coast Cellars estate is one of the largest contiguous vineyards in the Willamette Valley
- 100% estate grown and bottled = 100% control over vineyard planting practices and fruit quality
- From 2010-2013 the Oregon category's volume rose 39% to 2.7 million cases while winery revenues surged nearly 50% to \$363 million dollars*
- The number of wineries in the state has roughly doubled over the past decade to more than 600 *Oregon Wine Board



SUSTAINABILITY AND CONSERVATION EFFORTS

We pride ourselves on a commitment to the land and preservation of it for generations to come. From our LIVE certified vineyards to our homegrown vegetables we strive to uphold the highest standards of sustainability and innovation. We are one of 14 wineries to complete [Oregon Environmental Council's Carbon Reduction Challenge](#), one of 6 to undergo an independent audit to achieve complete carbon neutrality and a charter member of The Climate Registry representing the largest greenhouse gas reduction effort in U.S. wine industry history. Additionally, we offer a Bottle Recycling Program for every empty Left Coast Cellars bottle that is returned to our tasting room for recycling, we take \$1 off each new bottle purchased.
