Below are listed questions that teachers, parents or guardians can ask children that will guide and stimulate the reading experience.

- What is the most important lesson the main character/s gained in the story?
- What part of the story did you favor most and why?
- What part of the story did you least favor and why?
- If you were given the opportunity to rewrite any part of this story, what would you change?
