

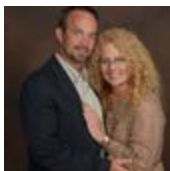
Welcome to our annual Go Global Missions Conference. Stop by the lobby to visit the various missionary displays.

J & K - Creative Access Nation

J & K have made it their life's purpose to take the gospel where Christ has not been named - reaching unreached peoples. God used this passion to move them from 20 years of vocational ministry in the states to East Asia in 2002. J & K are honored to be your representatives on the front lines to finish the task of the great commission.



Jim & Sybil Eberhard - Kenya

The Eberhards arrived in Kenya in July 2009 as career missionaries with the Baptist Bible Fellowship International (BBFI). They have had a part in starting eight local churches with national pastors in Kenya. Jim teaches at Nairobi Baptist Bible College. They helped establish Kenya Baptist Missionary Service to help churches network together to send and support church planters and missionaries.



Lance & Melanie Gotcher - Philippines

The Gotchers have served as BBFI missionaries in the Philippines for the past 18 years. Their main church meets in six locations around Metro Manila, with 23 total locations on their island. They also have churches in Cambodia and Saudi Arabia, planted by missionaries sent from their church. They minister to over 50,000 public high school students and have 12 MANNA feeding centers. Baptist College of Leadership is in its 12th year of training leaders to plant churches in the Philippines and abroad.



Richie & Missy Orrick - Wales

In 2008, the Orricks were approved as BBFI missionaries to Wales. In 2012, they followed God's lead and returned to the United States where they were asked to come on staff at their sending church, Cherry Street Baptist Church. They were reinstated as BBFI missionaries in May 2016 and are currently on deputation raising their much-needed support to return to the post-Christian country of Wales.

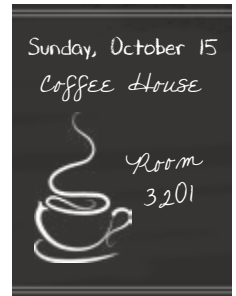
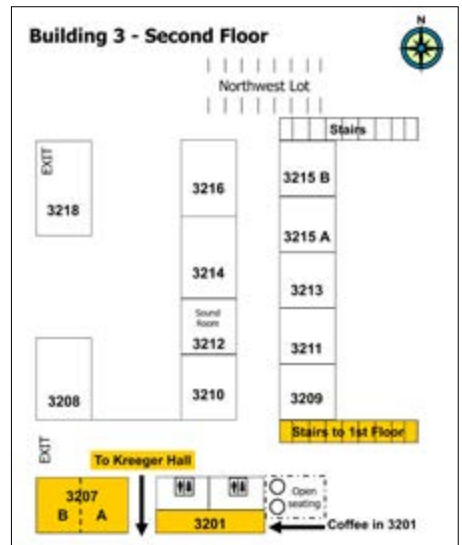
