*Varietal: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, 2% Petit Verdot*

*Port of Call: Napa Valley*

*Vessel: Fermented in stainless steel tank. Aged 18 months  
90% French Oak (25% new) - 10% American Oak (new)*

*Winemaker: Brian Mox*

*On board: 2296 cases*



*Logbook: Fresh nose of blackberry, cassis and touches of dried violet. The palate is fullbodied with pure notes of blueberries intermingled with chocolate, caramel and hints of bacon.*

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
