



MOTHER'S DAY REFLECTION

On Sunday, Eunice Hui (Pastor Ben's wife) shared with us a couple key verses from her journey with God through the years. In lifegroup this week we'll take time to dive deeper into these verses and create space for God to speak to our hearts.

FAMILY TIME

- Praise reports: a way for us to encourage each other about what God is doing and to build our faith for continuing to pray.
- Prayer requests: a chance for us to pray for each other and watch these prayer requests become future praise reports.

INTRODUCTION QUESTION

- What was a highlight from Mother's Day weekend for you? (Pay attention to any points of pain here. This could be a good place to practice courage, empathy, and connection like we've been discussing in lifegroup over the last few weeks)

DISCUSSION

We'll be looking more deeply at the three key passages Eunice preached on from this past Sunday. Break into groups of 3-4 and either have them pull up this lesson on their phones or you can printout the sheet below. Let the groups know how much time they'll have to go over this and instruct them to make sure to pray for each other before they end.

Matthew 13:45-46

45 “Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. **46** When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it.

Q: Are there some counterfeit pearls you need to let go of in order to purchase the Great Pearl?

John 15:1-4

15 “I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. **2** He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. **3** You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. **4** Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

Q: What face of God is He wanting to reveal to you right now? Who does God want to be for you in your current season?

Song of Songs 2:10-13

10 My beloved spoke and said to me, “Arise, my darling, my beautiful one, come with me. **11** See! The winter is past; the rains are over and gone. **12** Flowers appear on the earth; the season of singing has come, the cooing of doves is heard in our land. **13** The fig tree forms its early fruit; the blossoming vines spread their fragrance. Arise, come, my darling; my beautiful one, come with me.”

Q: Is there an invitation from God to arise and step into a new place, ministry, work, or relationships?
