5 LIFE-CHANGING TRUTHS ABOUT GOD

The Love of God

Pastor John will be preaching on the voice of God this Sunday. This week we'll be studying one of the key passages for our church—where God speaks to Moses face to face. As you know, this is the basis for what we now call “facetime.” We're hoping that people will understand that God desires to speak to us face to face. Feel free to think through how to help your people grow in hearing God's voice.

Introduction Question: What's a “voice” that stands out to you and why? It could be a friend's voice, or something from a movie.

Bible Study: Exodus 33.7-11

⁷ Now Moses used to take a tent and pitch it outside the camp some distance away, calling it the “tent of meeting.” Anyone inquiring of the Lord would go to the tent of meeting outside the camp. ⁸ And whenever Moses went out to the tent, all the people rose and stood at the entrances to their tents, watching Moses until he entered the tent. ⁹ As Moses went into the tent, the pillar of cloud would come down and stay at the entrance, while the Lord spoke with Moses. ¹⁰ Whenever the people saw the pillar of cloud standing at the entrance to the tent, they all stood and worshiped, each at the entrance to their tent. ¹¹ The Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent.

Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1) What strikes me from this text and why?
- 2) What do I learn about God?
- 3) What do I learn about people or myself?
- 4) What might God want to say to me through this text?
- 5) What am I going to do this week as a result?
