## World Mandate Sunday

We had a great World Mandate West weekend! (Messages from the conference will be available soon if you're interested) Guest speaker Ron Parrish preached a great word Sunday on the Great Commission passage, encouraging all of us to go and make disciples. This week in lifegroup we want to create space for folks to process and share about their experiences from World Mandate West as well as to consider what *going* might look like for them in this next season.

**VISION:** Explain the purpose of lifegroup.

### FAMILY TIME:

- Introduction Question: Where's somewhere you've gone recently that impacted you in some way?
- Share praise reports and prayer requests.

### DISCUSSION:

Let's start by processing World Mandate for those who were able to go down to San Diego this weekend or were at church on Sunday. For those who did not get to go, this is a chance for them to also be blessed and to grow through others' sharing.

- What stood out to you from the conference?
- What did you learn?
- What do you feel like God was saying to you?

**Matthew 28:18-20** - <sup>18</sup> Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Discussion Questions:

- What strikes you from this text and why?
- What do you learn about Jesus?
- What do you learn about yourself/people?
- What might God want to say to you through this text?

- What can we do to step into Jesus' call to go and make disciples?

## **PRAYER MAPS**

Let's (re)create relational prayer maps. On a sheet of paper, list out the major communities you are a part of on a weekly basis (e.g., work, family, gym, friend-groups, etc). Then ask God to bring to mind specific individuals in those various communities that God might want to draw closer to him in this next season. Then ask these questions:

- How can I make space in my schedule to pray for these folks this week?
- Is there something God might want me to do in order to help these folks encounter God in some way?

End the night by praying for each other to be able to go as we help those around us encounter God!
