DISCUSSION: JOHN 7.37-39

³⁷ On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. ³⁸ Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them." ³⁹ By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

- What stands out to me from this passage?
- What do I learn about people?
- What do I learn about Jesus?
- What do I learn about the Holy Spirit?
- What might God want to say to me from this passage?
- What does it look like to put this passage into practice this week?
- Close by praying for each other.

PRACTICAL EQUIPPING:

God wants to fill us with his Spirit. Sometimes, we don't realize how much God wants to fill us up with rivers of living water. As a result, we don't always ask or expect that to take place. For our practical tonight, let's close by first praying for ourselves to overflow with God's living water then praying for each other to overflow as well!
