Children accompanied by parents or a caregiver can now attend the "Sing and Play" classes offered once a week starting January 11 for four weeks (January 11, 18, 25 and February 1). Classes will meet on Fridays at 10:45 to 11:45 a.m. The hour-long classes will give new mothers a place to meet other new mothers and an opportunity for smaller children to meet and play with others and to listen and learn Japanese language through song and play. No prior Japanese knowledge required.
