Our building construction objective is to create bases in the communities where discipleship and training can serve the church and community. We also envision medical missions and business development teams using the building. This is a great opportunity to bring transformation to communities and a nation.



BICC was chosen for construction because they had made and burned 40,000 bricks and owned land. We have many churches in our network of 270 churches working toward this same goal. The following photos show the progress of the construction.



This project is our first funded building and the local church is doing all the construction and progressing well. Our vision is to have U.S. churches or individuals funding \$10,000 for materials and go help with construction and then minister to the community to help grow the church.
