**Admissions consultation** regarding Admission for September 2018

As the admissions' Authority for the schools within the Bishop Wheeler Catholic Academy Trust, the Directors wish to consult in accordance with the Admissions Code on the following changes to the boundaries covered in the admissions policies for St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School Pudsey, a Voluntary Academy and St. Mary's Menston, a Catholic Voluntary Academy. The Bishop has authorised under canon law the change to parish boundaries as given in the description below:

*"After consulting the Council of Priests on 13th July 2016, I wish to inform you that the boundaries of the Parish of St Joseph, Pudsey and the Parish of St Mary, Bradford have been redrawn with the territory bounded by Bradford Road, Daleside Road, Galloway Lane and the Calder Valley Railway Line being ceded to the Parish of St Joseph, Pudsey".*
