- There will be a **welcome folder** in your lodge when you arrive; it will have maps and other important information.
- Visit our **Camp Store** for new Alabama Folk School merchandise! Hours are written on the sign at the front door.
- **Cell phone service** is limited at camp. AT&T works the best, all other providers are extremely limited and typically do not transmit.
- Please remember our **speed limit** is 10 MPH. **Parking directions** will be posted around different areas of camp; we ask that all guest adhere to those directions.
- There is **WIFI** available in various meeting locations. Some buildings are password protected, and some are not. The Camp Guest password is "campmcdowell"
- We **do not allow pets** on camp property
- The **closest towns** to Camp are Jasper (17 miles) and Double Springs (10 miles)
- If you need **ice**, please visit one of our kitchens during working hours with your cooler.
- Be mindful that the **Farm at McDowell** is only accessible with a scheduled staff person.
- Please turn off all **lights** and **air/heat** before you depart. We also ask, if staying in lodges, that you place your **sheets and towels** in the common area of your lodge (or down the laundry chute if staying in Miller or Parsley Commons).
