Who should attend Leadership Camp?

Middle Level Leadership Camp is open to...

- students enrolled in middle schools or junior highs entering grades 7, 8 or 9.
- students holding elected offices or students with an interest in developing leadership skills.
- students who are part of the official school delegation.

What curriculum is covered?

Middle Level Camp is a unique leadership experience designed specifically for middle level students. The staff is composed of enthusiastic, highly trained and dedicated teachers, administrators, business leaders and college students. The curriculum is based on the goals and objectives of the **Association of Washington Student Leaders**. Through large group and small group activities, students learn a variety of skills that will help them in their development as positive school leaders. Some of the topics include:

Where is Leadership Camp?

Three sessions are held at Cispus Learning Center, 12 miles southeast of Randle, Washington, in the Gifford Pinchot National Forest. One session is held at Chewelah Peak Learning Center, approximately one hour north of Spokane near the 49 Degrees North ski resort. Both facilities are operated by the Association of Washington School Principals. Family-style meals are served in the dining hall and delegates are housed in dorms.

Registration Details

Reserve Your Spaces

On a space available basis from February 1 – June 15, schools may reserve delegate spots with a School Registration Form and purchase order or payment. If Delegate Registration/Medical Forms are not postmarked by June 15, reserved spaces will be relinquished. After June 15 only packets including delegate forms will be accepted.

Delegate Forms

Register only students who can commit to their camp session from start to finish. Delegates must be entering grades 7, 8 or 9 and be registered as a part of the school delegation. Please verify that Delegate Registration/ Medical forms are legible and signed by parents and students. Collect, sign and mail forms as a packet **by June 15**. DO NOT FAX delegate forms. Delegation Size and Registration Rates

Cispus - maximum 14 delegates per school, per session / 4 days-3 nights - \$225/\$240 (AWSL Member/Non-Member)

Chewelah - maximum 12 per school / 4 days-3 nights - \$225/\$240 (AWSL Member/Non-Member)

Camp Selection

The most important consideration when selecting a session of camp is date. Find a session that all delegates can commit to from start to finish. All sessions teach to the same goals and objectives and all are structured to meet the needs of middle school and junior high leaders.

Adviser Workshop

An optional adviser workshop runs concurrently with each session of camp. Participants attend their own seminar, designed specifically for middle level advisers. Mail a complete and signed Delegate Registration/Medical Form for each adviser attending. Twenty clock hours are available for \$40. Fees, registration and cancellation policy are the same as for student delegates.

Cancellation Policy

All cancellations received after June 15 will result in a non-refundable processing fee of \$50. Full charges apply for cancellations made less than five working days prior to camp. Full charges apply for delegates who leave early or do not show up for camp. All cancellations must be received in writing from a school official by the specified date.
