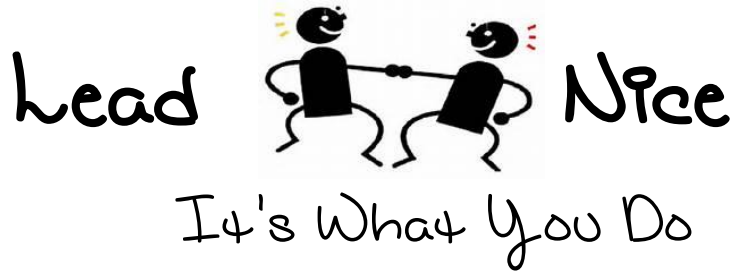

**Facilitators** are staff members from AWSL summer leadership camps

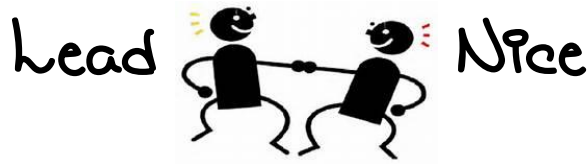
