Arrival

Wednesday, June 21st -- the first session will begin at 2:00 p.m.

Approximate travel time to Cispus from Seattle is 3 hours; from Yakima is 2 hours.

Enclosed driving directions will be VERY helpful. We invariably have lost or very late delegates! Do NOT count on your GPS directions being accurate. You will lose service as you get closer to Cispus.

Meals

Our first meal will be dinner on Wednesday. Breakfast will be at 8:00 a.m. each morning. Camp meals are served family style and consist of traditional, hearty fare. If you have special dietary needs contact Heather or Karen in the Leadership Office to make arrangements.

Seminar Schedule

From Highway 167 (near Auburn) take the Highway 512 exit to Puyallup. From 512 take the Puyallup/South Hill exit. Follow to Eatonville. At the intersection in Eatonville turn left and continue to Alder Lake. Turn left onto Highway 7 and continue through Elbe. Turn right on the Nisqually River Bridge and continue to Morton. Follow through town to Highway 12. Turn left (east) and continue 17 miles to **Randle**.

From Interstate 5 take exit 68 (Highway 12: White Pass, Yakima), turn left (east) and follow toward Morton. Continue 48 miles to **Randle**.

From Eastern Washington take Highway 410 outside of Yakima and continue through Naches. Turn left (west) onto Highway 12 and continue over White Pass and on to **Randle**.

From Randle, turn south onto Highway 131 toward Mt St Helens. At approximately one mile, take the left fork, Cispus Road, also called Forest Road #23. The Center is approximately 11 miles ahead. The road is well marked with Forest Service signs. Follow the signs to the Cispus Center.
