Dear Parent/Guardian,

Welcome to the Association of Washington Student Leaders' leadership camp program. Our leadership camps have been offered to students in Washington State since 1956. The program is facilitated and supervised by staff of the Association of Washington School Principals.

Your student was selected to represent their school at this leadership camp. As representatives of their schools, delegates will be expected to be positive participants in all activities. In general, camp rules shadow basic school rules: wear appropriate clothing, respect yourself and others, be on time, etc. Those students who do not follow camp behavior expectations will be sent home.

Your students' school has chosen to attend one of our four middle level camp sessions. Three sessions are held at **Cispus Learning Center**, 12 miles southeast of Randle, Washington. One session is held at **Chewelah Peak Learning Center**, approximately one hour north of Spokane. Both facilities are operated by the Association of Washington School Principals. Family-style meals are served in the dining hall and delegates are housed in gender separated and well supervised dormitories.

This leadership camp experience is designed specifically for middle school students entering grades 7 - 9. The staff is composed of enthusiastic, highly trained and dedicated teachers, school administrators, business leaders and college students. Delegates learn a variety of skills that will help them in their development as individuals and as positive school leaders. Some of the topics include:

- Communication Skills
- Positive Teamwork
- Problem Solving
- Decision Making
- Involving Others in Your School
- Successful Meeting Skills
- Organizing Yourself
- Sensitivity to Others

Delegates are on a very busy schedule at leadership camp and **cell phones will not work at our remote locations**. Please realize you may not be in contact with your child for 4 days. If you would like them to have the ability to call home during recreation time, they will need to come with a pre-paid calling card. You will be able to call the camp office in the event of any family emergency.
