2017 Design Awards

Call for Entries

Project Eligibility

- For all architectural projects, construction must have been completed after Jan. 1 2012.
- Entries may be submitted in one of the following categories:

Interior Design or Tenant Improvement Projects

Newly Completed Projects: Residential, Institutional, Private/General Commercial Historic Preservation, Rehabilitaion or Adaptive Reuse

Urban Design Projects, may involve landscape architecture & civic improvements (projects can be theoretical or under implementation; the project need not be completed) Small Projects under 2,000 SF (may include installations)

Unbuilt Design or Studio Projects

- Built projects must be submitted by the design architect who must be a member of the AIA, and a
 registered architect at the time the project was executed (if the project requires an architect).
- Individuals or firms whose offices are located in El Paso may enter projects located in any
- geographical location, of any size, and any budget.
- Temporary installations and built studio projects designed by emerging professionals, students, and faculty must have been completed after 2012.
- For projects executed in collaboration with other firms, all contributing parties must be attributed.
- Multiple entries for the same project by successor individuals or firms will not be accepted.

Submission Criteria

- Presentations must contain no more than 12 slides per project; however each slide may contain
 more than one image. Presentations shall be submitted in a PDF file not to exceed 30MB. PDF file
 name shall be "project name_entrant or firm name.pdf"
- Floor plans and a site plan or aerial photo are required.
- Include graphic scales, directional arrows, and indications of context or preexisting conditions
 to ensure a complete understanding of the project. Provide both interior and exterior photos of the
 project.
- The first image of the presentation should include the project title, square footage and location.
- Each presentation should include a description of the project indicating the project's primary
- design problem.
- The name of the entrant or entrant's firm shall NOT be visible on any of the images or on any slides
 of the pdf presentation; if this happens the entry will be disqualified.
- Each submittal should include one image that is 690 pixels wide and 300 pixels tall to be published
 on the AIA El Paso website.
- Each submittal should include one 40" x 40" presentation board of the project. Selected winners' boards will be displayed at the AIA Gala.
