

**GLITTER BLESSING:  
A Glitter+Fire Street Ministry**

Scripture tells us that on Pentecost the Holy Spirit divided into tongues of fire, empowering the disciples to speak to people gathered in Jerusalem in the language of home, the most intimate language of people's hearts.



On Pentecost Sunday, it is appropriate to offer blessings to people outside of church as well as in. If you belong to a church, you can do this right outside your church walls. If you do not belong to a faith community, you can do this in any public space. You may want to post a sign to indicate that you are offering Pentecost Glitter Blessings.

Glitter Blessings can be offered by sprinkling a bit of glitter on a person's head. You may offer these words, or something like this:

**Whatever your native tongue is, whatever language reaches most deeply into your heart, know this: You are treasured by God.**

*sprinkle with glitter*

**May the blessing of God**

**who has created you,  
who calls you by name,  
who sets you free,**

**be upon you, and set your heart on fire with love, this day and forevermore.**
